III. Principal’s/Teacher’s Remarks – Mindy Cline, Principal

- a. Thanks for Carolyn Nugent and Barbara Martin for attending meeting.
- b. Thanks to PTO for funding half of the field trip to the Masonic Temple for Dayton Philharmonic concert.
- c. Registered 148 new kindergarteners this week. This is 10 more than 2010.
- d. Proposed a musician, Jim McCutcheon – The Guitar Man, coming in to give a concert during the day as a reward for a school based program.
- e. Reminder about spring teacher allotments. Each teacher will receive \$150.
- f. Teachers gave a technology “wish list”. On the top of their list was getting an additional 12 laptops to join 10 that are already at PVN. This would be allow enough for a whole classroom. Teachers are also interested in having more digital cameras and flip cameras. Lastly, the district is purchasing large projection screens for each classroom. An overlay allows the screen to become a “touch screen” that the students can interact with. Mindy mentioned that the overlay cost approximately \$1100 and 19 classrooms could use them. Discussion included purchasing these for some or all classrooms over an undetermined amount of time.
